Candidates may be voted for by placing two intersecting lines in the circle beside the name of the candidate, for example: X,+

(The ballot paper shall indicate, beside the name of the nominating organisation registered by the court, at its request, the abbreviation of the nominating organisation. In the event of joint candidates, the ballot paper shall indicate the name of each nominating organisation.

If the candidate is entered into the register by the election body as a candidate representing a national or ethnic minority, then the name of such minority shall be indicated on the ballot paper. At the request of the candidate representing the minority, or the nominating organisation of the minority, the ballot paper shall indicate the name of the candidate, the name of the nominating organisation and the name of the minority also in the mother tongue of the minority.)
